**2013 PINOT NOIR**

**CLONE:** 100% Wente

11 months in barrel

30% New French Oak

**HARVEST DATE:** August 29, 2013

**PRODUCTION NOTES:**

The fruit was hand sorted, night harvested and brought to the winery on August 29, 2013. It was destemmed and left whole berry as it went into 1-ton fermenter bins; where the fruit cold soaked for five days. Next, we added (AMH) Assmanshausen yeast and had a nice and steady fermentation. At just about dryness, we drained off the skins to barrels and pressed off separately to neutral barrels. The wine then went through 100% Malolactic fermentation. A few months post ML; the wine was racked and returned to barrels where it stayed until bottling in August 2014.

**TASTING NOTES:**

This delicate pinot noir has bright cranberry, rhubarb, black cherry, tea leaf and baking spice notes on the nose. On the palate it is balanced with bright acidity and is light to medium bodied with bursting flavors of strawberry, plum, cinnamon, vanilla, spice and black tea.
