11 months in barrel

30% New French Oak

100% French Oak Remond Cooperage

HARVEST DATE: August 12, 2014

BRIX AT HARVEST: 23.8

PRODUCTION NOTES:

The pinot noir grapes were night harvested on August 12, 2014, and cold soaked for five days in one-ton fermenter bins. Whole berry fermentation with (amh) assmanshausen yeast was followed by the free run juice and pressed fruit going into separate barrels for aging and secondary fermentation - 100% malolactic. 3 months later the wine was racked and returned barrels until bottling in August 2014.

TASTING NOTES:

This delicate pinot noir has bright cranberry, rhubarb, black cherry, tea leaf and baking spice notes on the nose. On the palate it is balanced with bright acidity and is light to medium bodied with bursting flavors of strawberry, plum, cinnamon, vanilla, spice and black tea.
